TANK-GUARD® Protection Plan Overview

- All oil tanks must be pre-qualified prior to initial TANK-GUARD® treatment. A service technician will come to your home, review your tank, and submit an eligibility report to verify that your tank qualifies for our TANK-GUARD® Plan. We use visual inspection guidelines as recommended by the National Oilheat Research Alliance (NORA).
- If your tank qualifies, our service team will schedule a work order to have your tank treated with a concentrated TANK-GUARD® liquid corrosion inhibitor. (You do not need to be home for this appointment, TANK-GUARD® is administered through your oil tank's fill pipe.)
- Your TANK-GUARD® Protection Plan will automatically be renewed each year and your tank will be treated annually with the TANK-GUARD® corrosion inhibitor.
- The concentration is heavier than oil and settles at the bottom of the tank to neutralize acidity and shield the inside bottom of the oil tank with a molecular film, thus reducing rusting, electrolytic pitting, and sludge.
- TANK-GUARD® is safe, effective, and does not affect your furnace's performance or fuel efficiency.
- If your tank leaks from internal corrosion while it is enrolled on the Tank-Guard® Program, Palmer Gas & Oil will arrange to replace the tank, and you will receive a generous credit toward the replacement cost.



TANK-GUARD® Protection Plan Terms

- TANK-GUARD® Protection Plans are in effect for 12 months and will be renewed automatically each year thereafter at prevailing rates. Palmer Gas & Oil will indicate its acceptance of a plan by issuance of an invoice, made payable within 30 days. A tank must be pre-qualified before it is accepted for a protection plan. Advance payment does not make a plan become effective.
- Plans canceled within 30 days of renewal date will receive a full refund provided TANK-GUARD® product has not been administered for that renewal. (If TANK-GUARD® has been administered then no refund will be issued.) Plans may be canceled after 30 days of renewal date but there will be no refund of any unused portion of the plan.
- Plans are for residential customers only.
- A protection plan is transferable to a new owner at the option of the property seller for the existing service location, or the plan may be voided at the owner's request, but there will be no refund of any unused portion of the plan.
- Palmer Gas & Oil will endeavor to render prompt and efficient service, but it is expressly agreed that Palmer Gas & Oil shall in no event be liable for damage or loss caused by delay or any loss arising out of the performance of this plan.
- The customer's payment constitutes their acceptance of the terms and conditions of this protection plan.
